Following a competitive selection process, City of Harvard has selected Dynegy as the electric supplier for our municipal aggregation program through **October 2023**. You will automatically be enrolled in the program as a City of Harvard resident. There are never any switching or early termination fees.

Program Details:

- The program offers a fixed low rate of **\$0.06217 per kWh guaranteed until October 2023**.
- Your current billing method will not change. You will continue to receive one monthly invoice from ComEd.
- This is a firm fixed all-inclusive rate.
- There is no enrollment, switching or early termination fee.

If you choose not to participate in this program, please contact Dynegy by returning the enclosed opt out card or calling (844) 351-7691 **by September 3, 2021** regardless if you have opted out of programs in the past.
