



City of Xenia Electric Aggregation Program

Dear Xenia Residents and Businesses,

We are writing to tell you about the City of Xenia's next Electric Aggregation Program. In November 2013, Xenia voters gave City Council the authority to form a governmental aggregation program to negotiate a favorable electric price and terms for its residences and businesses. City Council has selected Dynegy, a competitive retail electric service provider, as the electric supplier.

Here's What to Expect:

- You receive a Fixed Electricity Price of 5.04¢/kWh through your May 2021 meter reading.
- You receive **one energy bill** including the Dynegy charge from DP&L, your local utility.
 - Budget billing will only be available for the DPL charges on your bill. Please contact your electric utility for more information.
- After your enrollment is finalized, DP&L will send you a confirmation letter.
- You can leave the aggregation program without penalty, anytime.

You're Automatically Enrolled

There is no cost to enroll. Enrollment is automatic for those who are eligible, but participation is voluntary. You may opt-out of this program without penalty by **April 16, 2018** or leave the program at any time for any reason by providing notice to Dynegy. Please see the enclosed terms and conditions for full details of the program.
